CHALLENGE

The small team had experienced significant change and growth. They were looking for support in the development of team culture and performance. Positive communication and improvement were required to align departments and remove silos. Cultural diversity was a challenge.

SOLUTION

We completed team culture interviews and facilitated a 24-hour Team Performance Training Series over twelve months. The program focused on Self-Awareness, Team Awareness, the Power of Team Norms and Team Engagement.

Developed greater self-awareness which also increased team awareness on a global basis

Created a strong understanding of the varying socio-cultural backgrounds and how flexing is vital for team performance and a successful end result
